

Pre-Purchase Exam Request Form Disclosure Statement

A Prepurchase exam is a thorough physical and, if requested, ancillary diagnostics (i.e. radiographs, bloodwork) stating a veterinary opinion of the horse on the day of the exam. The horse is observed under saddle as well as in hand through all gaits. The horse will also be observed after a series of flexions, which stress target joints in the horse's limbs to exacerbate any underlying musculoskeletal issues.

It is the responsibility of the buyer to inform the examining veterinarian of the intended use of the animal as well as any pertinent information in the horse's history. The buyer must also inform the veterinarian which diagnostics you would like performed if the horse moves past the basic examination. Pre-purchase examinations can become quite expensive, so please familiarize yourself with the fee schedule listed on the following pages.

The performing veterinarian will give you an opinion as to whether or not the horse has any indication of problems at the time of the exam. We cannot predict the future of any horse. It should be understood that the veterinarian does not issue any warranty on any particular case, and if one is desired it should be contracted with the seller.

Oftentimes, buyers and sellers expect that the horse will "pass" or "fail" the pre-purchase examination. It is not Four Star Equine's policy to follow this rhetoric; all of the information gained by the veterinarian on the day of the exam will be given to the potential buyer in order for them to make the best judgement as to the talent, disposition and suitability of the horse – only the buyer is able to decide if these parameters meet his/her satisfaction.

Pre-Purchase Examination Summary of Fees

Clinical and Moving Examination: \$325

Begins with a comprehensive evaluation of the horse's respiratory, cardiovascular, musculoskeletal, ophthalmic, gastrointestinal and neurologic systems. A cursory examination of the external genitalia will be performed unless a breeding soundness exam is requested (recommended for breeding stock). Baseline soundness and flexion tests of the fore- and hindlimbs will be evaluated with the horse in hand. The horse will also be evaluated at the walk, trot and canter on the lunge line or under saddle or both (as is needed).
